

Vocabulary- I use **Tectonic plates** The outermost layer of the earth is called the crust and it is broken into large pieces called tectonic plates. an imaginary line around the Earth that goes exactly midway Equator between the North Pole and the South Pole and divides it into two equal halves, the Northern Hemisphere and the Southern Hemisphere. the imaginary line that divides Earth into two equal parts: Prime Meridian the Eastern Hemisphere and the Western Hemisphere. Longitude a system of lines used to describe the location of any place and Latitude on Earth. the parallel of latitude that is 23½ degrees south of the Tropic of equator and is the southernmost latitude reached by the Capricorn overhead sun. **Tropic of Cancer** the parallel of latitude that is 23½ degrees north of the equator and is the northernmost latitude reached by the overhead sun. cover the top and bottom of planet Earth at the North and **Polar Region** South Poles. Natural resources something that is found in nature and can be used by people. inorganic substances, meaning that they do not come from Minerals an animal or a plant.


