Home learning

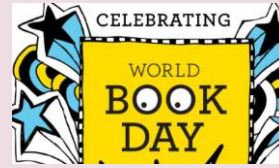


Please help your child with their reading at home and make sure that you date and sign their Reading Record Book so that they get their reward points in class. Some children are slipping having not read much at home lately.
