- 2) Scan down the text to find key words or information in the main text that will help you to find your answer
- 3) Use part of the question to help you to start your answer
- 4) Use full sentences
- 5) Write neatly in joined up handwriting
- 6) Read the question and answer again to check that your answer makes sense
