This week your focus is the human heart.

These tasks are to be spread out across your week – don't rush!

Take your time to produce quality work and to remember what you're learning. Do your best to complete the work but don't worry if you don't finish everything, you can always finish at a later date.

Answers are provided for parents and carers, who wish to mark their child's work.

Task 1 – Read the text carefully. It's useful to read it twice all the way through to check you've understood everything. If there are any words you don't know the meaning of, use a dictionary to help you understand its meaning.

Task 2 – Answer the comprehension questions. You could do this in your Learning Journey, if you don't have a printer.

Success Criteria:

If you're writing in your Learning Journey, write the title: ***The Human Heart – Reading Comprehension*** – at the top of your page.

- 1) Read the question carefully and find the key parts. Read it again to be sure you understand what you're being asked to do.
- 2) Use skimming or scanning to find key words/information in the main text that will help you answer the question.
- 3) Use part of the question to help you start your answer.
- 4) Use full sentences to answer the question. Check your sentences make sense when you read them aloud.
- 5) Use a capital letter and full stop to punctuate your sentence. Use a capital letter to punctuate proper nouns.
- 6) Use neat, joined up handwriting.
- 7) Read the question and your answer again, from start to finish, to check you've answered the question.
